






Which statement best describes your household? 2,077 responses




On average, how many recycling containers does your household put out for collection? 2,077 responses









Cost is more important than the type of service (sticker vs toter). 2,074 responses




The ability to control our costs is my household's most important priority. 2,078 responses




If the sticker program on average was more expensive than the toter service, my household would still choose to stay with the sticker program.




The quality of service is more important to me than the cost of the service.




















